1. Award Conditions

***Award Conditions to the Financial Assistance Award
Between the Denali Commission and Alaska Village Electric Cooperative
For Alakanuk and Emmonak Power Plant and Bulk Fuel Upgrade
Award No. 1425, Amendment 1
April 2013***

All changes to the award conditions are noted below.

1. Scope of Work

This amendment provides \$8,000,000 for final design, procurement, and construction of a 3 megawatt power plant and 560,000 gallon bulk fuel storage for the power plant to serve the communities of Alakanuk and Emmonak, Alaska. Match funding in the amount of \$2,000,000 will be provided by Alaska Village Electric Cooperative, Inc. (AVEC). The site selection process will evaluate locating the new power plant proximate to the community's water treatment plant and potentially other community facilities, which would support the inclusion of a recovered heat system which would capture excess heat off the power plant's generators and supply it to the water plant. The scope also includes the upgrade of 12,000 gallons of fuel storage for the water plant.

2. Award Performance Period

The amended Award performance period is September 1, 2012 through September 30, 2015. This is the period during which Award recipients can incur obligations or costs against this Award.

There are no other changes to the original Financial Assistance Award, as amended.
