The Alaska Department of Transportation & Public Facilities (DOT&PF), in cooperation with the Denali Commission (DC), invites you to attend an Open House to discuss the Tanacross Road Improvement Project. This project will consist of resurfacing roadways in and around Tanacross, including access roads from the Richardson Highway to the village and the airport. We are requesting public comments, and presenting the scope of work for the proposed project. You are welcome to come in at any time between 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. **At 4:30 there will be an informal presentation about the project.**

The purpose of the Tanacross Road Improvement Project is to improve safety, enhance community health by reduced or eliminated dust issues, extend the road life and reduce maintenance requirements by upgrading several locations where the underlying gravel has settled unevenly. The project need is to address significant safety and health problems resulting from dust and air-borne particles on roads around and leading to the village of Tanacross. The existing surface will have Crushed Aggregate Base Course, Grading D-1 added where needed, and a calcium chloride dust palliative applied, with the village roads the primary emphasis.
