Scope of Project: Site Improvements to Existing Health Clinic

Deficiencies Requiring Correction:

The Alakanuk Health Clinic provides primary and urgent care services for a community of 659 residents. This modern facility, built in 2000, was funded through the HUD ICDBG program. However, the funds did not cover final site improvements and grading around the clinic. The Denali Commission was approached to obtain these funds and complete the exterior improvements.

Impact of Improvements Upon the Community/Region:

In April of 2002, the Denali Commission provided \$90,927 to the Yukon Kuskowim Health Corporation to perform site grading and gravel pad improvements to the Clinic. This work was completed in 2003 and has resulted in site grading and stabilization to obtain proper drainage. In addition, a parking area was added for the all-terrain vehicles prevalent in the community.
