A resolution by the Native Village of Napaskiak in support of having the mooring points (anchors) installed at the designated sites are shown on the map attached to this resolution.

WHEREAS, the Native Village of Napaskiak (hereinafter "Tribe") is a federally recognized tribe; and

WHEREAS, the Napaskiak Tribal Council (hereinafter "Council") is the governing body of the native Village of Napaskiak, Alaska, and

WHEREAS, the Denali Commission will provide assistance to tribes for the purpose of installing mooring points.

WHEREAS, our Tribal Council fully supports the installation of two mooring points sites within fifty (50) to sixty (60) feet inland as shown as map attached to this resolution.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Napaskiak Tribal Council hereby authorizes the Denali Commission to install two mooring points at the designated site as shown on the map attached to this resolution in Napaskiak, Alaska.
