Pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Grant/Award, this Authorization:

Background: AVTEC-Alaska's Institute of Technology, partnered with the Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium (ANTHC) to develop training programs that will certify rural water treatment plant operators, while providing hands-on practical training in building maintenance skills. This new program offering will help rural communities build their internal capacity to maintain private and public facilities in their villages. Most of the participants are rural operators and will need to be trained on computer diagnostic troubleshooting, testing and maintenance.

Laptop computers are required for this training element and have been approved as student equipment for the purpose of this important training. Funds from this award in the amount of \$18,789.00 will be used to buy 8 (eight) laptops for the use of mechanical classroom NCCER maintenance for water utilities and community facilities.

In connection and concurrent with this award, AVTEC was awarded funds through the Alaska Department of Labor, Denali Training Fund (DTF) project # 1134-D to provide training to rural participants.
