





A. INTRODUCTION

The ANTHC, DEHE, role is to provide lasting solutions to promote healthy communities.

B. SCOPE OF PROJECT

This project will complete the design studies and construction planning for a new health clinic in Skagway, Alaska. No construction will be performed under this project phase.

C. PROJECT FUNDING

The project was originally funded by \$309,000 of Commission funds, via Financial Assistance Award No. 220-06, Amendment No. 1, dated September, 2006.

D. REVISION OF PROJECT FUNDING

This amendment completes the design funding for the project by adding \$312,803 via Award No. 288-07 Amendment No. 2, dated September 2007, which brings project funding to a total of \$621,083.
