



A. INTRODUCTION

Throughout this Amendment these entities are referred to as follows:

Village of Takotna	=	Village
Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium	=	ANTHC
Financial Assistance Sub-Award	=	FSA
Denali Commission	=	Commission

On Nov. 8, 2002, ANTHC and the Village of Takotna executed an FSA authorized by the Denali Commission to perform the design and the construction planning for a new health clinic in Takotna, Alaska. No construction was performed under this project phase.

The project was funded with \$100,200, via Denali Commission Financial Assistance Award Project No. 0019-DC-2001-I1, dated March 2001. (However, the project was identified in 0071-DC-2002-I24, April 2002.)

On July 6, 2005, ANTHC and the Village of Takotna executed an Amendment No. 1 to the CPA to add \$34,356, via Denali Commission Financial Assistance Award Project No. 0071-DC-2002-I24, Amendment No. 1, dated September 2002.

B. REVISION OF SCOPE OF PROJECT

This Amendment expands the scope of work to perform further geotechnical work and supply a geotechnical report, thereby providing the information necessary for clinic foundation design.

C. REVISION OF PROJECT FUNDING

This Amendment adds \$23,730, via Denali Commission Financial Assistance Award Project No. 185-05, Addendum D, dated January 2007.

Project funding therefore totals \$158,286.
