All changes to the award conditions are noted below.

**1. Scope of Work**

This amendment does not add funding to the Financial Assistance Award. Funding for these projects has been approved through previous authorization in the Financial Assistance Award. This amendment authorizes the State of Alaska, Department of Health and Social Services to proceed with the following subprojects.

**Juneau Youth Services (JYS) – Awarded \$50,000 under Amendment 2**

Scope of work to include the legal activities associated with the proposed joint service delivery partnership between JYS and Southeast Alaska Regional Health Consortium (SEARHC). It is understood that the total project cost is \$125,000 and that the A-DHSS contribution is \$75,000. The Commission's funding shall not be contributed to the project manager portion of the scope of work however it is authorized for use toward legal consultation and services associated with the production of contractual agreements necessary for SEARHC and JYS to best determine feasibility and structure of a proposed joint service delivery model.

This scope of work replaces the original scope outlined for this project in Amendment #2 to this award dated February 2005 which indicated that the JYS funding in the amount of \$50,000 was intended for design funding. That scope of work, through this amendment, is void.

**Deliverable: Final Agreement between JYS and SEARHC regarding service delivery partnership and supporting analysis report in a format appropriate for public review to be completed by June 30, 2006.**

**Southcentral Foundation (SCF) – Awarded \$90,000**

Scope of work is clarified to include a literature review and associated analysis and report to assess best practices for service delivery of youth psychiatric needs that are culturally targeted. In addition, the conceptual design (35%) of a youth psychiatric facility shall be completed. Procurement policies within the A-DHSS requirements shall be adhered to.

**Deliverable: Service delivery report and conceptual design (35%) for proposed facility with cost estimates to be completed by June 30, 2006.**

**Fairbanks Interior Center for Non-violent Living—Awarded \$1,500,000 by Financial Assistance Award #136, Amendment #2 adjusted to \$1,000,000**

Authority to proceed in awarding this project is hereby granted. This project has completed all due diligence.

**Alaska Family Resource Center (AFRC) – Increase to \$700,000. Amendment 2 allocated \$475,000, Amendment 3 allocates an added \$225,000.**

This project previously was allocated \$475,000 and was pending due diligence completion. Final design costs require an additional \$225,000 to demonstrate a fully funded project. Authority to proceed in awarding this project is hereby grants. This project has completed all due diligence.
