***Award Conditions to the Financial Assistance Award
Between the Denali Commission and Kenai Peninsula Borough
For Solid Waste Equipment Purchase
Award No. 152-05, Amendment 1
July 2005***

All changes to the award conditions are noted below.

1. Scope of Work

This amendment awards an additional \$96,179 to support the Kenai Peninsula Borough (KPB) acquisition of a mobile air curtain burner to use at the waste facilities located in Soldotna, Homer and Seward. The unit would be available for use at remote landfills and for other borough projects such as wildfire mitigation and clean-up. By eliminating the volume of wood waste and other debris, the air curtain burner will extend the life and capacity of the KPB landfills and reduce the capital investment needed to continue to perform this critical borough service. The KPB commits \$6,000 for in-kind services associated with this project. Actual equipment will be purchased in accordance with KPB procurement regulations.

2. Award Performance Period

The amended Award performance period is January 1, 2005 through December 31, 2005. This is the period during which Award recipients can incur obligations or costs against this Award.

There are no other changes to the original Financial Assistance Award, as amended.
