All changes to the award conditions are noted below.

1. Scope of Work

This amendment does not change the funding of this award.

This amendment provides:

1. Authorization to proceed with the funding for a list of Domestic Violence repair, renovation and equipment purchase projects, approved for funding at the January 2006 Commission meeting (\$162,043.47), and
2. Authorization to proceed with a design award to the Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium (ANTHC) for the Multi-use Clinic/Domestic Violence project located in New Stuyahok (\$245,000).

The addition to scope for these projects details as follows:

Domestic Violence – Repair, Renovation and/or Equipment Projects (\$162,043.47)

Funding in the amount of \$162,043.47 shall be deducted from the domestic violence construction pool (0136-DV-POOL) for these projects, making the remaining balance of this pool, after this amendment, \$204,950.78.

The following projects have completed all due diligence by the Council on Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault (CDVSA) and the Denali Commission and are ready to proceed to funding:

The A-DHSS is authorized to fund the above projects in the amounts listed and coordinate with the CDVSA on meeting the Commission's reporting requirements. The

A-DHSS shall obtain, through the CDVSA, documentation of cost share match amounts by recipient as a condition of this award.

The A-DHSS is accountable for all subprojects to this award. The A-DHSS shall coordinate with CDVSA with the goal of a single agency point of contact for recipients, however the A-DHSS will at any time communicate directly with recipients in order to meet grant requirements.

The performance period for this award will not change, however these projects are expected to complete all work by September 30, 2006.

Design - ANTHC award for New Stuyahok Multi-use Clinic/DV Facility

A total of \$335,000 of Domestic Violence funding was awarded for this project (06-4-C-5020) in Amendment 2 to this award. \$245,000 is now authorized to proceed for design. This leaves a balance of \$90,000 for the construction of this project, to be authorized at a later date.

The ANTHC shall be the sub recipient of this award, and will manage the design of the project on behalf of the community of New Stuyahok, in coordination with the Bristol Bay Area Health Corporation (BBAHC). This funding is accounted for in the FY04 Domestic Violence funding strategy.

All due diligence required by the Denali Commission for this design award has been completed. Construction funds are not authorized at this time.

2. Award Performance Period

There are no changes to the performance period.

There are no other changes to the original Financial Assistance Award, as amended.
