All changes to the award conditions are noted below.

***1. Scope of Work***

This amendment does not change the funding of this award. This amendment provides:

A. Authorization to proceed with a design award to the Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium (ANTHC) for the Domestic Violence project located in Bethel, Alaska (up to \$300,000). Amendment 6 to this award provided authorization to proceed with a direct award to the Tundra Women's Coalition (TWC). This Amendment 9 redirects the A-DHSS Facilities Section to provide this funding to ANTHC instead of TWC. The project number remains 06-4-C-5031.

A total of \$300,000 of Domestic Violence funding is authorized to proceed for design to be award directly to the ANTHC. The ANTHC shall be the sub recipient of this award, and will manage the design of the project on behalf of the TWC.

The ANTHC shall manage the design process and through the Denali Commission's June 2006 Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the ANTHC, a 20% fee for this service is allowable for management of the TWC design award. After this fee, the funding available for the design contract totals \$240,000.

Any unutilized funding for the design contract shall be dedicated to the construction award. Construction funds are not authorized at this time. All due diligence required by the Denali Commission for this design award has been completed.

B. This Amendment creates a new project, the Dillingham Domestic Violence Shelter Construction (06-4-C-5114), and is funded \$190,650 from the Domestic Violence Pool (136-DV-POOL) for construction. This project is authorized to proceed as all due-diligence has been completed. This will fund the construction of a new Arctic Entry and expand the existing shelter to include a second floor above the original Thrift Shop.

***2. Award Performance Period***

There are no changes to the performance period.

There are no other changes to the original Financial Assistance Award, as amended.
