

All changes to the award conditions are noted below.

1. Scope of Work

No funding changes are made to this award.

This amendment allocates \$468,186.28 from the Repair & Renovation Pool (project 199-05-B). An additional \$1,250,000 is allocated from the Youth Psychiatric Facility Construction Pool (project 199-05-C) for a total project award amount of up to \$1,718,186.28. These funds will be used for the planning and design of the youth psychiatric facility in Eklutna, Alaska with Southcentral Foundation. This new project will be numbered 06-4-C-5116.

Southcentral Foundation is authorized to proceed in design activities as detailed in the approved scope of work which totals \$1,718,186.28 of expenses. Only current design activities are authorized at this time. Future design activities shall be requested by the applicant to the Denali Commission in writing and if approved will be authorized via amendment to this award. As stated in Resolution 06-16, this project was identified by the Health Steering Committee as the priority project for the program.

This action makes the balance of 199-05-B \$781,813.72 and the balance of 199-05-C zero.

2. Award Performance Period

The amended Award performance period is extended to August 25, 2005 through July 1, 2008. This is the period during which Award recipients can incur obligations or costs against this Award.

There are no other changes to the original Financial Assistance Award, as amended.
