1. Scope of Work

Reference Denali Commission letter of October 19, 2006 (copy attached), expanding the scope of this award: It is confirmed that you may use remaining Denali Commission funds for any activity that promotes the success of the seawall adjacent to the bulk fuel farms, and concomitantly the remaining seawall. This includes direct construction activities as well as support activities such as material and labor for equipment maintenance and protection for equipment and materials being used for the seawall construction.

2. Award Performance Period

The Award period is extended by this amendment, due to the onset of winter and freezing conditions that prevent further work until spring. The amended Award performance period is May 23, 2006 through June 30, 2007. This is the period during which Award recipients can incur obligations or costs against this Award.

There are no other changes to the original Financial Assistance Award, as amended.

Dear Mayor Whiting:

Annabelle Avite has asked us for a determination on whether remaining Denali Commission funds may be used in the on-going repair efforts on the Kivalina Seawall. The purpose of the Commission funded portion of the project was to protect the existing bulk fuel infrastructure in Kivalina. That section of the seawall is not currently in active failure mode. However, the project also required that a continuous seawall be constructed to provide the best hope of successful protection. Because the failure of the seawall adjacent to the segments funded by the Commission threatens the integrity of the entire seawall, it is appropriate to use remaining Commission funds in your efforts to repair failed segments of wall, or to provide alternate shoreline protection in those areas.

Your expenditures through September 30th showed a balance of Commission funds of \$363,656.99, however, I do not have information about any outstanding obligations or expenditures since that time. Please keep the Commission informed of your activities in this on-going work. I hope that the fall storm season will be gentle, so further damage is less likely.
