1. Scope of Work

Additional funding of \$4,996,516.00 is provided for the previously approved projects shown on the attached spreadsheet. AVEC match for the Huslia bulk fuel project number 52A, in the amount of \$45,266.00 is recognized in this amendment. There are no changes to the scope of work created by this amendment.

2. Award Performance Period
