## RESOLUTION NO. 06-10

### A RESOLUTION ON FY06 SOLID WASTE PROGRAM FUNDING

**WHEREAS**, The FY 2006 Agriculture Appropriations Bill (HR. 2744 Section 753) appropriated \$750,000 from US Department of Agriculture Rural Development to the Denali Commission Solid Waste Program to remain until expended, \$ 750,000 to address deficiencies in solid waste disposal sites which threaten to contaminate rural drinking water supplies; and

**WHEREAS**, there was enthusiastic response from qualified communities in rural Alaska to participate in the FY 2005 program as outlined in the Request For Proposals (RFP), and improvements are in progress across the state that will deliver examples of effective technology; and


**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Commission allocates up to \$712,500 of FY06 funding plus \$196,150 carried over from FY 2005 to the FY 2006 RFP cycle for the solid waste program to assist communities in their management of solid waste in a manner that is locally appropriate and will improve both local and downstream impacts to drinking water supplies,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that up to \$100,000 that was made available in FY 2005 for evaluating state-wide solid waste management strategies remains available during FY 2006.
