### RESOLUTION NO. 03 – 04 A RESOLUTION REGARDING COMMUNITY PRIORITIES PROGRAM FOR FEDERAL FUNDING FOR FY03

WHEREAS, the Denali Commission established the Community Priorities Program (CPP) in 2001 (Resolution No. 01-04) to respond to community needs for fixed infrastructure project support outside of the Health facilities and Energy facilities program areas, and

WHEREAS, the CPP was created to encourage development of comprehensive community plans, and

WHEREAS, the CPP was targeted at economically distressed communities, and any communities with a population below 1500, and

WHEREAS, the Commission has allocated a total of \$6.7 million to the program in FY 2001 and 2002, and

WHEREAS, the CPP has funded a total of 9 projects with a total value of \$2.6 million, and

WHEREAS, the CPP has funded many kinds of fixed infrastructure projects, and

WHEREAS, the CPP has a low success rate of submitted projects being funded, and has not achieved the primary program objective;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Denali Commission discontinue the Community Priorities Program after the current pre-applications have been appropriately dealt with, and be it


FURTHER RESOLVED, the remaining CPP funds be re-allocated to other programs.


CERTIFICATION
